



Use this keyboard to help solve these puzzles



Wondering what to do? Just follow the instructions

- Write the names of the white keys on the keyboard diagram
- Find the starting note (in the 1<sup>st</sup> box of the puzzle) on the keyboard – point to it
- Follow the directions in the next box – move your finger
- Write the name of the note you have reached on the dotted line
- Repeat this for each box
- If you've counted correctly each group of letters will spell a word



Want to know what a semitone is?

It's the distance between any key on the keyboard and the very next key up or down

Here's a clue – on a keyboard **up** means to the **right** and **down** means to the **left**

So **high** means near the **right-hand end** of the keyboard  
and **low** means near the **left-hand end** of the keyboard

Start on a low	Go <b>up</b> 4 semitone steps	Go <b>up</b> 3 semitone steps	Go <b>up</b> 4 semitone steps
<b>F</b>	.....	.....	.....

Start on a high	Go <b>up</b> 2 semitone steps	Go <b>down</b> 12 semitone steps	Go <b>up</b> 10 semitone steps
<b>D</b>	.....	.....	.....

Start on a high	Go <b>down</b> 2 semitone steps	Go <b>down</b> 3 semitone steps	Go <b>down</b> 2 semitone steps
<b>A</b>	.....	.....	.....

Start on a low	Go <b>up</b> 10 semitone steps	Go <b>up</b> 5 semitone steps	Go <b>down</b> 3 semitone steps
<b>E</b>	.....	.....	.....
